## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Environment – Bay Restoration Fee – Mobile Home Park

- FOR the purpose of specifying a Bay Restoration Fee for a group of not more than a
  certain number of mobile homes under single ownership that is connected to an
  onsite sewage disposal system and does not receive a water bill; and generally
  relating to the Bay Restoration Fee.

#### 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(1) (i) Beginning on July 1, 2012, the Bay Restoration Fee is:

17 1. For each residential dwelling that receives an
18 individual sewer bill and each user of an onsite sewage disposal system or a holding
19 tank that receives a water bill:

A. \$2.50 per month if the wastewater generated by a residential dwelling is treated at a wastewater facility that does not discharge into the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed;

1 В. \$2.50 per month if the onsite sewage disposal system  $\mathbf{2}$ or holding tank is not located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal 3 **Bays Watershed**; C. 4 \$5.00 per month if the wastewater generated by a  $\mathbf{5}$ residential dwelling is treated at a wastewater facility that does discharge into the 6 Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed; and 7D. \$5.00 per month if the wastewater onsite sewage 8 disposal system or holding tank is located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or 9 the Coastal Bays Watershed: 10 2.[For] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM 5 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, FOR each user of an onsite sewage disposal system that does not 11 12receive a water bill: 13\$30 per year if the onsite sewage disposal system is A. not located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed; or 14

B. \$60 per year if the onsite sewage disposal system is
located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed;

173.For each user of a sewage holding tank that does not18receive a water bill:

A. \$30 per year if the sewage holding tank is not located
within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed; and

B. \$60 per year if the sewage holding tank is located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed; [and]

4. For a building or group of buildings under single ownership or management that receives a sewer bill and that contains multiple residential dwellings that do not receive an individual sewer bill or for a nonresidential user:

A. For each equivalent dwelling unit not exceeding 2,000 equivalent dwelling units, \$2.50 per month if the wastewater generated by a building or group of buildings containing multiple residential dwellings is treated at a wastewater facility that does not discharge into the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed;

B. For each equivalent dwelling unit not exceeding 2,000 equivalent dwelling units, \$5.00 per month if the wastewater generated by a building or group of buildings containing multiple residential dwellings is treated at a wastewater facility that does discharge into the Chesapeake Bay Watershed or the Coastal Bays Watershed; and

1 C. For each equivalent dwelling unit exceeding 2,000 2 equivalent dwelling units, zero; AND

#### 5. FOR A GROUP OF NOT MORE THAN 25 MOBILE HOMES UNDER SINGLE OWNERSHIP THAT IS CONNECTED TO AN ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM AND DOES NOT RECEIVE A WATER BILL, \$2.50 PER MONTH FOR EACH EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNIT.

7 (ii) For a nonresidential user, the Bay Restoration Fee may be 8 calculated based on an estimate of equivalent dwelling units of wastewater effluent 9 generated, if the nonresidential user's wastewater bill is based on wastewater 10 generated and not on water usage.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2014.
