- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a member of the Anne Arundel County Board of 5 Education who vacates the office before the expiration of the term for which the 6 member was appointed from being a candidate for election to a municipal, 7 county, or State office during a certain period of time immediately following before the conclusion of the term to which the member was appointed; providing 8 9 an exception; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the candidacy of a member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education for 10 11 election to another local or State office.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 21 22	(2) A member of the county board is eligible for nomination and reappointment for a second consecutive term in accordance with the provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this section.
23 24 25	(3) (i) The approval or rejection of a member of the county board by the registered voters of the county provided for in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph shall be a vote for the member's retention or removal.
26 27 28 29	(ii) On receipt of the notice required under § 5–301(h) of the Election Law Article, the name of the member of the county board shall be placed or the appropriate ballot and shown, without opposition, and the voters shall vote for or against the member's retention as a member of the county board.
30	(4) If the voters reject the retention of the member, or the vote is tied:
31 32	(i) The position shall become vacant 10 days after certification of the election returns; and

3	(d) (1) The student member shall:
4 5	(i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;
6 7	(ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;
8	(iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and
9 10	2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
11 12 13	(2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils shall:
14	(i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and
15 16 17	(ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous student member of the board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.
18 19	(e) A board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall be replaced as a member.
20 21 22	(f) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member of the county board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.
23 24 25 26	(g) (1) The President of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education is entitled to receive \$8,000 annually as compensation and, except for the student member, the other board members are entitled to receive \$6,000 each annually as compensation.
27 28 29	(2) A student member who completes a full term on the board shall be granted a scholarship of \$6,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education costs.
30 31	(H) (1) A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF A BOARD MEMBER VACATES THE OFFICE BEFORE THE

EXPIRATION OF THE TERM FOR WHICH THE MEMBER WAS APPOINTED, THE BOARD MEMBER MAY NOT BE A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO A MUNICIPAL,
