MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) (1) A person may not willfully disobey any lawful order or direction of any police officer.
- 3 (2) This subsection may not be construed to authorize a Police officer at a motor vehicle checkpoint, as defined in § 25–114
