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## Health - Down Syndrome - Required Information

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to identify certain information about Down syndrome; requiring the Department to make available certain information on the Department's Web site and to provide certain information to certain health care facilities and certain health care providers; requiring certain health care facilities and certain health care providers to provide to certain individuals certain information under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the identification and provision of information about Down syndrome.

- 10 DOWN SYNDROME EDUCATION AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES,
- 11 INCLUDING INFORMATION HOTLINES, RESOURCE CENTERS, AND
- 12 CLEARINGHOUSES.
- 13 **(B)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 14 (1) PROVIDE THE INFORMATION IDENTIFIED BY THE
- 15 DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO HEALTH CARE
- 16 FACILITIES AND HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT PROVIDE PRENATAL CARE,
- 17 POSTNATAL CARE, OR GENETIC COUNSELING TO EXPECTANT PARENTS WHO
- 18 RECEIVE A PRENATAL TEST RESULT FOR DOWN SYNDROME AND PARENTS OF A
- 19 CHILD DIAGNOSED WITH DOWN SYNDROME; AND
- 20 (2) MAKE AVAILABLE THE INFORMATION IDENTIFIED BY THE
- 21 DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ON THE
- 22 DEPARTMENT'S WEB SITE.
- 23 (C) (1) ON RECEIPT OF A POSITIVE TEST RESULT FROM A TEST FOR
- 24 DOWN SYNDROME, A HEALTH CARE FACILITY OR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER
- 25 SHALL PROVIDE TO THE EXPECTANT PARENT WHO RECEIVES A PRENATAL TEST
- 26 RESULT FOR DOWN SYNDROME OR THE PARENT OF THE CHILD DIAGNOSED
- 27 WITH DOWN SYNDROME THE WRITTEN INFORMATION PROVIDED OR MADE
- 28 AVAILABLE BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 29 (2) THE INFORMATION PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 30 SHALL BE CULTURALLY AND LINGUISTICALLY APPROPRIATE FOR THE
