1 AN ACT concerning

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## Teaching Fellows for Maryland Scholarship Program

3 FOR the purpose of renaming the Maryland Teacher Scholarship to be the Teaching 4 Fellows for Maryland scholarship and altering certain elements of the 5 scholarship program; requiring certain institutions of higher education to 6 provide certain matching funds to participate in a certain program; altering the 7 eligibility criteria and the service obligation for the scholarship; authorizing 8 certain recipients to work in certain public schools and certain public 9 prekindergarten programs to satisfy a certain service obligation under certain 10 circumstances; altering the amount of a certain award; requiring certain 11 institutions of higher education to develop and implement a certain honors 12 program in response to certain dedication and accomplishment under certain 13 circumstances; requiring the Governor annually to include certain funds in the 14 State budget for the Maryland Higher Education Commission to make certain awards under this Act; requiring certain awards to be made in certain years; 15 requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance to award certain 16 scholarships in a manner that reflects ethnic, gender, racial, and geographic 17 18 diversity; altering certain definitions; making a stylistic change; and generally 19 relating to scholarships for individuals who pledge to work as public school and 20 public prekindergarten teachers.
