16	(a) Except for a law enforcement officer in the line of duty or as provided in
17	Subsection (b) of this section, a person may not discharge a firearm:
18	(1) Within 150 yards of a [building which can be used as a residence
19	whether occupied or vacant] DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR OTHER
20	BUILDING, WHETHER OCCUPIED OR VACANT, EXCEPT THOSE APPROVED FOR
21	THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS, SUCH AS TRAINING FACILITIES OR INDOOF

- 1 (2) On any property owned by another person or by Calvert County 2 without evidence of permission on his person.
 - (b) The County Commissioners may, by ordinance, authorize a bona fide veterans' organization to conduct, for fund—raising purposes, an organized shooting event that is not subject to the restrictions provided in Subsection (a)(1) or (2) or both, of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2014.
