- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 18 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each county 19 superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the county board.
- 20 (2) In Prince George's County, the Chief Executive Officer is entitled 21 to the compensation set by the contract with the county board.
- 22 (b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during 23 his term of office.
