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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Superintendent of Schools – Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Anne Arundel County Board of Education from  
4 paying monetary compensation to the county superintendent of schools for sick  
5 leave benefits earned in a certain manner; authorizing the county board to allow  
6 the county superintendent to use certain sick leave in a certain manner; and  
7 generally relating to the compensation for the Anne Arundel County  
8 superintendent of schools.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article – Education  
11 Section 4–202  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 4–202.

18 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each county  
19 superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the county board.

20 (2) In Prince George’s County, the Chief Executive Officer is entitled  
21 to the compensation set by the contract with the county board.

22 (b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during  
23 his term of office.

1                   (2)     Each county superintendent shall devote full time to public school  
2 business.

3                   **(C)     IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT PAY**  
4 **MONETARY COMPENSATION TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT FOR SICK**  
5 **LEAVE BENEFITS WHILE EMPLOYED BY ANY OTHER BOARD OF EDUCATION OR**  
6 **PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM BUT MAY ALLOW THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT TO**  
7 **USE THE SICK LEAVE IN THE SAME MANNER AS SICK LEAVE ACCRUED WHILE**  
8 **EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY.**

9                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
10 October 1, 2014.
