Article – Correctional Services

IF AN INMATE IS TRANSFERRED FROM ONE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO ANOTHER CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, THE TRANSFERRING FACILITY SHALL SEND AS PART OF THE TRANSFER:

19(1) A NOTIFICATION REGARDING THE TRANSFER TO THE COURT20ORDERING THE COMMITMENT OF THE INMATE AND TO THE STATE'S21ATTORNEY'S OFFICE THAT PROSECUTED THE INMATE;

22 (2) THE COMMITMENT RECORD OF THE INMATE, INCLUDING 23 RESTITUTION INFORMATION UNDER MARYLAND RULE 4–351(A)(6);
