# Maryland Health Care Commission – Authority of Acute Care Hospitals to Provide Cardiac Surgery Services – Voluntary Relinquishment – Regulations

FOR the purpose of requiring that certain regulations adopted by the Maryland
Health Care Commission provide for the voluntary relinquishment of the
authority of certain acute care hospitals to provide cardiac surgery services
under certain circumstances; and generally relating to regulations concerning
the voluntary relinquishment of authority to provide cardiac surgery services.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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### Article – Health – General

- 18 (g) (2) The regulations shall:

19 (v) Require, as a condition of the issuance of a certificate of 20 conformance or a certificate of ongoing performance [to an acute general hospital 21 without on-site cardiac surgery services], that [the] AN acute general hospital agree 22 to voluntarily relinquish its authority to provide CARDIAC SURGERY SERVICES, 23 emergency PCI services, or elective PCI services if the hospital fails to meet the 24 applicable standards established by the Commission;
