- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (l) **(1)** The Chief Judge of the Court for Frederick County shall receive an annual compensation of [\$6,500] **\$11,000**.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the judges of the Orphans' Court of Frederick County while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the judges of the Orphans' Court of Frederick County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed of elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.
