- FOR the purpose of providing that the State Board of Elections shall have a general 4 counsel; providing for the appointment, qualifications, and tenure of the general 5 6 counsel; authorizing the State Board to request professional assistance from the Attorney General to assist the State Board in the performance of its duties, 7 subject to a certain condition, the Attorney General shall provide professional 8 9 legal assistance to the State Board of Elections; providing that, if the State 10 Administrator of Elections makes a certain determination, the State 11 Administrator, on confirmation by majority vote of the State Board, may retain the services of independent legal counsel to provide professional assistance to 12 the State Board and the State Administrator; and generally relating to legal 13 counsel to the State Board of Elections. 14
