3 Extension of Purchase Period

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Executive Director of the State Retirement 5 Agency, under certain circumstances, to extend the period of time during which 6 certain members of the State Retirement and Pension System who are 7 separated from employment may purchase service credit for a certain leave of 8 absence; requiring the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension 9 System to adopt certain regulations; providing for the retroactive application of this Act for certain individuals; and generally relating to the period of time 10 during which service credit may be purchased for a leave of absence by certain 11 12 members of the State Retirement and Pension System.

- 14 (3) separated from employment with the State on or before April 1,
