9 10 11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, on or before December 1, 2014, the State Department of Education shall, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, report to the General Assembly on the following:
13 14	(1) existing broadband speeds and connections in all public schools in the State, including capabilities from the main building to classrooms; and
15	(2) each local school system's plan to:
16 17	(i) reach a broadband speed of 1 gigabyte per 1,000 students for each public school by fiscal year 2020 through public and private efforts; and
18 19	(ii) offer support and training programs in the use of education technology tools for classroom teachers.
20 21 22 23	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2014. It shall remain effective for a period of 7 months and, at the end of December 31, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
