2 **Baltimore City Sheriff's Office – Deputy Sheriff Majors – Number of**
3 **Appointments**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of deputy sheriff majors that the Sheriff of
5 Baltimore City is required to appoint; and generally relating to the number of
6 deputy sheriff majors appointed in Baltimore City.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 2–309.

16 (d) (1) (ii) The Sheriff:

17 1. Shall appoint an undersheriff or chief deputy sheriff,
18 one assistant sheriff, [three] **FOUR** deputy sheriff majors, three deputy sheriff
19 captains, six deputy sheriff lieutenants, one secretary sheriff, and one fiscal clerk
20 sheriff; and

21 2. May appoint up to a maximum of:

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2014.
