That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 Article - General Provisions 5-506.16 17 An official or employee may not intentionally use the prestige of office or public position for that official's or employee's private gain or that of another. 18 19 The performance of usual and customary constituent services, without additional compensation, is not prohibited under subsection (a) of this section. 20
