- 1 (b) The Commissioner elected President of the Board shall receive an 2 additional \$3,000 per year.
- 3 (c) Each County Commissioner may be reimbursed up to an annual total of \$2,000 for any reasonable expenses incurred by the Commissioner in carrying out the functions of the office.
- 6 (d) Each County Commissioner is entitled to health insurance and to other 7 fringe benefits regularly provided to county employees.
- 8 (e) A Commissioner may not receive any other compensation for services as a 9 Washington County Commissioner.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to 11 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County or a County 12 13 Commissioner of Washington County while serving in a term of office beginning before 14 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County and a County Commissioner of 15 Washington County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of 16 office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the 17 18 effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
