A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Capital Grant Program for Public School Systems With Significant Enrollment Growth

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Capital Grant Program for Public School Systems $\mathbf{5}$ With Significant Enrollment Growth; providing for the purpose of the Program 6 and requiring the Interagency Committee on Public School Construction to 7 implement and administer the Program; specifying certain requirements for 8 grants awarded under the Program; requiring the Interagency Committee to 9 award certain grants to certain county boards of education under the Program; 10 requiring the Interagency Committee to develop certain eligibility requirements and certain procedures and processes for grants awarded under the Program; 11 12requiring the Interagency Committee to adopt certain procedures; requiring the 13 Governor, beginning in a certain fiscal year, to provide a certain amount of money in the State budget for the Program each fiscal year; specifying that 14funding provided under the Program is supplemental to public school 1516 construction funding from other sources; defining certain terms; and generally 17relating to the Capital Grant Program for Public School Systems With 18 Significant Enrollment Growth.

2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 3 MEANINGS INDICATED.

4 (2) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM FOR 5 PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS WITH SIGNIFICANT ENROLLMENT GROWTH.

6 (3) "SIGNIFICANT ENROLLMENT GROWTH" MEANS STUDENT 7 ENROLLMENT GROWTH IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM THAT HAS EXCEEDED 8 150% OF THE STATEWIDE AVERAGE OVER THE PAST 3 YEARS.

9 (B) (1) THERE IS A CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL 10 SYSTEMS WITH SIGNIFICANT ENROLLMENT GROWTH.

11(2)THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR12PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS THAT ARE13EXPERIENCING SIGNIFICANT ENROLLMENT GROWTH.

14 (C) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED AND ADMINISTERED 15 BY THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION IN 16 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

17 (2) GRANTS AWARDED BY THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE 18 UNDER THE PROGRAM:

19(I)MAY NOT COVER MORE THAN 50% OF THE COSTS OF A20PROJECT;

21 (II) SHALL BE MATCHED BY LOCAL FUNDS; AND

22 (III) SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC 23 WORKS.

24 (D) THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE GRANTS FROM STATE FUNDS DEDICATED FOR THE
PROGRAM TO COUNTY BOARDS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC
SCHOOL SYSTEMS THAT ARE EXPERIENCING SIGNIFICANT ENROLLMENT
GROWTH;

29 (2) DEVELOP A PROCEDURE FOR A COUNTY BOARD TO APPLY 30 FOR A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM;

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1(3) DEVELOP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR A COUNTY BOARD2TO RECEIVE A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM, INCLUDING A REQUIREMENT FOR3A COUNTY BOARD TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO MATCH A GRANT AWARD; AND

4 (4) DEVELOP A PROCESS TO ALLOCATE GRANT AWARDS UNDER 5 THE PROGRAM.

6 BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2015 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR **(E)** 7THEREAFTER, IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN 8 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL THE 9 CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL \$20,000,000 ANNUALLY IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM OF THE 10 PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM THAT MAY BE USED ONLY TO 11 12AWARD GRANTS UNDER THE PROGRAM.

13(F) THE STATE FUNDING PROVIDED UNDER THE PROGRAM IS14SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF FUNDING15THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE APPROPRIATED FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL16CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES TO A COUNTY BOARD FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE.

17(G) THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES18NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect20 June 1, 2014.
