State Government - Commemorative Months - Native American American Indian Heritage Month

FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain month as Native American Indian Heritage Month; requiring the proclamation to urge certain organizations to observe the month with certain activities; and generally relating to Native American American Indian Heritage Month.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT NATIVE AMERICANS AMERICAN INDIANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM NOVEMBER AS NATIVE AMERICAN AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE MONTH.
- (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE NATIVE AMERICAN AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE

MONTH PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
