# Corporations - Members of Boards of Directors - Demographic Information - Report to Board of Public Works

This bill requires each corporation that has been awarded a contract by the State for more than \$250,000 during the previous year to submit a report by January 1 to the Board of Public Works (BPW) on the demographics of the corporation's board of directors, including (1) the number of members on the board; (2) the number of vacant positions; (3) the gender composition of the board; and (4) the race and national origin of the members of the board.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** BPW can carry out the bill's requirements with existing budgeted resources. To the extent that, over time, the volume of reports received by BPW becomes excessive, general fund expenditures by BPW may increase minimally for storage costs. No effect on revenues.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.

### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** There is no requirement in State law for corporations that receive State contracts to report on the demographics of their board of directors.
