#### **Income Tax Forms - Graphical Representation of General Fund Expenditures**

This bill requires the Comptroller to include on specified income tax forms a graph or picture representing how much of each general fund dollar received is spent on (1) education; (2) health; (3) public safety; and (4) any other category included by the Comptroller. The Comptroller, in consultation with the Department of Legislative Services and the Department of Budget and Management, must determine the manner in which the representation is made and which income tax forms will include the representation. This information must also be posted on the Comptroller's website with the instructions for the applicable income tax forms.


