11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Howard County is requesting a \$125,000 Bond Bill Grant for the design, construction and restoration of the 10,000 square foot manor house, barn and 4 acres of historic gardens. The Belmont site is located at 6555 Belmont Woods Road, in Elkridge. This property is adjacent to hundreds of acres of Patapsco Valley State Park.

The site consists of a 10,000 square foot manor house, caretaker residence, cottage house, maintenance shop, carriage house, barn and pathways. Proposed uses will be historic educational programs, nature programs, weddings, historic house-and-garden tours and meeting events, just to name a few.

This facility will draw visitors from throughout the County as well as adjacent jurisdictions. The County population to be served is currently in excess of 287,000 people. This facility can host catered events such as weddings, meetings, historic educational programs that will greatly benefit the local economy, particularly restaurants, hotels, and small markets. This will help preserve a vital piece of history that is located in the Elkridge area of Howard County.
