10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)				
<p>The Architecture and Basic Design School, Inc t/a, Baltimore Design School Fashion, is a 6 - 12 Baltimore City Public Transformation School. The focus of the curriculum is to prepare students for college in the fields of architecture, fashion and design. The school is operated by a 501 (c) (3) corporation under a Board of Directors. The new facility is owned by this non-profit corporation. The first students enrolled in the fall of 2011. Because the school is specializing in design, it is critical that the facilities have labs and studios with proper equipment.</p>				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The project is to build-out the labs, studios and classrooms provide permanent improvements and built in equipment required by design school curriculum. The building that was acquired for \$2 million in the spring of 2011 is now being renovated. These costs are being covered by a state tax credit and permanent financing that was secured in December of 2010 - 2012. The \$23.4 million renovation will be complete in the summer of 2013. The renovation does not include the finishing of studios, classrooms, and labs required by the school. The Baltimore Design School will need to raise all the funds required to complete this work. No funds are provided by the Baltimore City Public School System.

The total building is 120,000 sq. ft. and located in Station North Arts and Entertainment District. The facilities where those renovations will be made represent about half of the total square footage.
