10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)								

Since its founding in 1977, NCIA, a 501(c)(3) corporation, has been working on behalf of intellectually disabled adults and children and other disadvantaged populations in Maryland. NCIA employs over 600 and its headquarters has been in the Woodlawn area of Baltimore County since the late 1980s.

One of our major programs is our Youth In Transition (YIT) School. For over 20 years, NCIAs Youth In Transition School has served the educational needs of children unable to participate in traditional school programs. We are licensed by the Maryland Department of Education and accept referrals from local education agencies throughout the state. The Schools primary handicapping conditions are emotional disabilities, intellectual disabilities and/or autism. As most of our students will not have the capacity to receive high school diplomas, vocational training has become a primary focus in our curriculum. We currently offer six vocational training tracks including automotive, barbering, building maintenance, culinary arts, horticulture, and warehousing.

NCIAs Youth In Transition (YIT) School is expanding its vocational school located at 7130 Rutherford Road. The current facility is 21,000 square feet and the planned expansion is an additional 17,000 square feet. The primary purpose of the project is to provide students with state-of-the-art educational facilities with an emphasis on vocational training. The YIT School is scheduled to break ground in June 2014 and Phase I will be completed by September 2014. Phase 2 includes a new gymnasium and commercial kitchen.
