School programs include: functional academics; speech therapy; psychological, psychiatric, social work, counseling and case management; assistive technology; physical and occupational therapy; vocational and transitional services; and intensive collaborative programs designed for students within the Autism Spectrum

The Open Community Program operates 28 state-licensed group homes for adults throughout Maryland and Delaware. Benedictine is a fully approved, non-sectarian service provider caring for individuals with special needs without regard to racial, ethnic, or religious background, on Maryland's Eastern Shore.

*Replace Flooring in educational and residential sections of the building with vinyl plank flooring. *Replace the lighting throughout the facility to better meet the needs of the students and to increase energy efficiencies. Architect has recommended a reflective lighting option that is designed for the autistic population and will reduce energy costs by 20%

*Replace pool decking material and locker rooms with easy to clean, nonskid flooring.

*Various ramp and building access upgrades to meet the needs of the students and adults and improve security.

*Campus Security Upgrades to include expansion of security cameras; improved outside lighting and installation of additional key card door systems.
