Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed House Bill 221 – *Limited Lines – Travel Insurance*.

The bill alters specified provisions of law relating to limited lines insurance for transportation tickets to relate instead to limited lines travel insurance; authorizes the Maryland Insurance Commissioner to issue a limited lines license to an individual or a business entity to sell travel insurance; and authorizes a travel retailer to offer and disseminate travel insurance under specified circumstances under the direction of a limited lines travel insurance producer.

Senate Bill 79, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 221.
