AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 14 through 23, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – General Provisions

Section 5-205(b) and 5-812

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_ (H.B. 270) of the Acts of the General Assembly of  
2014)

BY adding to

Article – General Provisions

Section 5-820

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_ (H.B. 270) of the Acts of the General Assembly of  
2014)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 22, inclusive, and substitute:

“Article – General Provisions

5-205.

(b) (1) The Ethics Commission shall adopt by regulation model provisions  
for local governments AND SCHOOL BOARDS on:

(i) conflicts of interest;

(Over)

(ii) financial disclosure; and

(iii) regulation of lobbying.

(2) Model provisions adopted under paragraph (1) of this subsection may be:

(i) adopted by any local jurisdiction OR SCHOOL BOARD; or

(ii) imposed on a local jurisdiction OR SCHOOL BOARD in accordance with Subtitle 8 of this title.

5-812.

(a) If the Ethics Commission determines that a county or municipal corporation has not complied with AND HAS NOT MADE GOOD-FAITH EFFORTS TOWARD COMPLIANCE WITH the requirements of this part, the Ethics Commission:

**(1) MAY ISSUE A PUBLIC NOTICE CONCERNING THE FAILURE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PART, INCLUDING A LISTING OF SPECIFIC AREAS OF NONCOMPLIANCE; AND**

**(2) may petition a circuit court with venue over the proceeding for appropriate relief to compel compliance.**

(b) The circuit court may grant any available equitable relief.”;

in line 23, strike “**15-816**” and substitute “**5-820**”; and in line 25, strike “**15-812(A)(2)**” and substitute “**5-816(A)(2)**”.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 3, inclusive, and substitute:

**“(1) MAY ISSUE A PUBLIC NOTICE CONCERNING THE FAILURE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PART, INCLUDING A LISTING OF SPECIFIC AREAS OF NONCOMPLIANCE;”**;

and in line 12, strike “July” and substitute “October”.
