### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 7 through 16, inclusive, and substitute:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – General Provisions

<u>Section 5-205(e)</u>

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter (H.B. 270) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2014)

#### BY adding to

<u>Article – General Provisions</u>

Section 5-704.1

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter (H.B. 270) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2014)";

and in line 19, strike "State Government" and substitute "General Provisions".

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 9 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

# "<u>5–205.</u>

(e) (1) (i) [1.] The Ethics Commission shall provide a training course for regulated lobbyists and prospective regulated lobbyists at least twice each year on the provisions of the Maryland Public Ethics Law relevant to regulated lobbyists.

# [2.] (II) One training course shall be held each January.

- [(ii) An individual regulated lobbyist, other than the employer of a regulated lobbyist as described in § 5–701(a)(6) of this title, shall attend a training course provided under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph at least once in any 2–year period during which the lobbyist has registered with the Ethics Commission.]
- (2) When a person initially registers as a regulated lobbyist, the Ethics Commission shall provide the person with information on the provisions of the Maryland Public Ethics Law relevant to regulated lobbyists.".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 10, 12, 13, and 17, strike "15-703.1.", "15-701(A)(6)", "15-205(E)(1)", and "15-703(F)", respectively, and substitute "5-704.1.", "5-702(A)(6)", "5-205(E)(1)", and "5-704(F)", respectively; and in line 14, after "OF" insert "THE REGULATED LOBBYIST'S".
