# AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 126 (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 6 and 7, strike "as correctional officers"; in line 10, after "changes;" insert "<u>requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services</u> to submit a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before <u>a certain date</u>;"; and in line 11, strike "correctional officers" and substitute "<u>individuals</u> <u>employed in a State correctional facility</u>".

# AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 23, insert:

# "(V) <u>AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY</u> OR IN ANY OTHER CAPACITY THAT INVOLVES DIRECT PERSONAL CONTACT WITH AN INMATE IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY;";

and in lines 24, 27, and 30, strike "(V)", "(VI)", and "(VII)", respectively, and substitute "(VI)", "(VII)", and "(VIII)", respectively.

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 19, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before September 30, 2016, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Judiciary Committee, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the number of polygraph examinations submitted to or taken by correctional officers and employees of a State correctional facility, and the number of grievances filed or complaints made in response to

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polygraph examinations submitted to or taken by correctional officers and employees of a State correctional facility.";

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and in line 20, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
