### AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 619 (Third Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "- Organizational Licenses" and substitute "<u>Act of 2014</u>"; in line 6, after "purposes;" insert "<u>altering a certain restriction on the number of bottles of wine that may remain open at any one time at a wine sampling or tasting event in the County; prohibiting a single individual at an event from consuming more than a certain amount of wine from all brands in a single day; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations;"; and after line 17, insert:</u>

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages</u> <u>Section 8-406</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2011 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 6, after "LIQUOR" insert "FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE <u>PREMISES ONLY</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 16, insert:

#### "<u>8–406.</u>

(a) This section applies only in Frederick County.

(b) <u>A beer and wine sampling or tasting (BWST) license may only be issued</u> to a holder of a Class A license.

(Over)

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(c) <u>The annual license fee is \$200.</u>

(d) (1) <u>Applications for a BWST license shall be made on forms supplied</u> by the Board of License Commissioners.

(2) <u>Renewals of the license may be made at the time the regular</u> <u>license is renewed.</u>

(3) <u>A license may be granted without a hearing.</u>

(4) If application for a license is denied, the applicant may request a public hearing before the Board.

(e) (1) <u>A holder of a BWST license may allow consumption by a single</u> individual for sampling or tasting purposes of:

- (i) Not more than 1 ounce of a given brand of light wine; and
- (ii) Not more than 3 ounces of a given brand of beer.
- [(2) <u>A maximum of six bottles of wine may be opened at any one time.</u>]

### (2) <u>THE BOTTLES OF WINE THAT MAY BE OPENED AT ANY ONE</u> <u>TIME AT A WINE SAMPLING OR TASTING EVENT ARE:</u>

# (I) <u>All of the bottles in a wine preservation</u> system that the Board approves; and

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# (II) NOT MORE THAN SIX OTHER BOTTLES OF WINE OPENED BY A HOLDER OF A SOLICITOR'S PERMIT, THE HOLDER OF THE BWST LICENSE, OR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LICENSE HOLDER.

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## (3) <u>A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT CONSUME MORE THAN 6</u> OUNCES OF WINE FROM ALL BRANDS IN A SINGLE DAY.

[(3)] (4) The licensee shall notify the Board in writing at least 5 days prior to each event.

[(4)] (5) Once opened, each bottle used for the beer and wine sampling or tasting event shall be marked that it is to be used for that purpose only.

[(5)] (6) The contents of each bottle may not be mixed with any other bottle and all bottles shall be destroyed once they are empty.

(f) (1) <u>A BWST license is for on-premises consumption only.</u>

(2) Sampling or tasting of beer or wine may not be conducted from a drive-through window.

(G) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.".
