A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County – Superintendent of Schools – Compensation for Unused Leave on Termination of Employment

FOR the purpose of providing that the Anne Arundel County Board of Education, on termination of the employment of the county superintendent of schools, may compensate the county superintendent for unused leave earned while employed as county superintendent only in a certain manner; and generally relating to compensation for the Anne Arundel County superintendent of schools on termination of employment.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Education

Section 4–202

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

4–202.

(a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each county superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the county board.

(2) In Prince George’s County, the Chief Executive Officer is entitled to the compensation set by the contract with the county board.

(b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during his term of office.

(2) Each county superintendent shall devote full time to public school business.

(C) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "LEAVE" MEANS:

- (I) ANNUAL LEAVE;
- (II) COMPENSATORY LEAVE;
- (III) SICK LEAVE; AND
- (IV) PERSONAL LEAVE.

(2) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, ON TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT, WHETHER VOLUNTARY OR INVOLUNTARY, THE COUNTY BOARD MAY COMPENSATE THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT FOR UNUSED LEAVE THAT THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT EARNED WHILE EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY BOARD ONLY AT A RATE THAT IS COMPUTED AND PAID IN THE SAME MANNER AS THAT COMPUTED AND PAID TO A CERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY BOARD ON TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
