A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Public Safety – Correctional Facilities – Full-Body Scanners

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to deploy and use full-body scanners at certain correctional facilities; requiring the Department to make a certain report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to correctional facilities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(a) The Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall deploy and use at least one full-body scanner at each correctional facility within the jurisdiction of the Department as discussed in the final report of the Special Joint Commission on Public Safety and Security in State and Local Correctional Facilities.

(b) The Department shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the results of the deployment on or before December 31, 2014.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2014.
