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## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

### **Statewide Information Technology Master Plan – Inclusion of Cybersecurity Framework – Requirement**

FOR the purpose of requiring that the statewide information technology master plan developed by the Secretary of Information Technology include a cybersecurity framework; requiring that the Secretary consider materials developed by the National Institute of Standards and Technology in developing or modifying the cybersecurity framework; and generally relating to the inclusion of a cybersecurity framework in the statewide information technology master plan.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Article – State Finance and Procurement  
Section 3A–304  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

3A–304.

(A) The Secretary shall develop a statewide information technology master plan.

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

**(B) (1) THE STATEWIDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MASTER PLAN DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A CYBERSECURITY FRAMEWORK.**

**(2) IN DEVELOPING OR MODIFYING THE CYBERSECURITY FRAMEWORK REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL CONSIDER MATERIALS DEVELOPED BY THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF STANDARDS AND TECHNOLOGY.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
