A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Chesapeake College – Board of Trustees – Appointment of Members

FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint the members of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College from a list of at least a certain number of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by each county that supports Chesapeake College; and generally relating to the appointment of the members of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Education

Section 16–406

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2008 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

16–406.

(a) (1) The Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College consists of two members from each county that supports Chesapeake College who shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the House of Delegates, **FROM A LIST OF AT LEAST THREE QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY EACH COUNTY THAT SUPPORTS CHESAPEAKE COLLEGE.**

(2) The county superintendents of schools in the region are not ex officio members.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



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(b) (1) (i) The term of a member is 5 years and begins on July 1.

(ii) A member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(2) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a member appointed to begin a full term on or after July 1, 2006, may not serve for more than three 5-year full terms.

(ii) A term of a member that began before July 1, 2006, does not count toward the term limit established in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.

(c) Each member of the Board:

(1) Serves without compensation; and

(2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with applicable travel regulations.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2014.
