A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Wholesome Meat Act – Prohibitions – Equines and Equine Meat

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from buying, selling, transporting, or offering or receiving for sale or transportation any equine carcass or the meat of any equine if the person knows or reasonably should know that the carcass or meat will be used for human consumption; prohibiting a person from buying, selling, transporting, or offering or receiving for sale or transportation any equine if the person knows or reasonably should know that the equine is intended for slaughter for human consumption; and generally relating to equines, equine carcasses, and the meat of equines.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Agriculture

4–123.

No person may commit or cause the commission of any of the following acts:

(19) Giving or paying anything of value to any person employed to perform any official duties under this subtitle; [or]

(20) Receiving by any person, employed to perform any official duties under this subtitle, anything of value, given or paid by any person, to influence his official actions; OR

(21) BUYING, SELLING, TRANSPORTING, OR OFFERING OR RECEIVING FOR SALE OR TRANSPORTATION:

(I) ANY EQUINE CARCASS OR THE MEAT OF ANY EQUINE IF THE PERSON KNOWS OR REASONABLY SHOULD KNOW THAT THE CARCASS OR MEAT WILL BE USED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION; OR

(II) ANY EQUINE IF THE PERSON KNOWS OR REASONABLY SHOULD KNOW THAT THE EQUINE IS INTENDED FOR SLAUGHTER FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
