A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Health – Medical Laboratories – Advertising for or Soliciting Business – Repeal of Prohibition

FOR the purpose of repealing a prohibition on certain advertising for or soliciting business in the State for a medical laboratory; and generally relating to medical laboratories.

BY repealing

Article – Health – General

Section 17–215

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

[17–215.

A person may not directly or indirectly advertise for or solicit business in this State for any medical laboratory, regardless of location, from anyone except a physician, hospital, medical laboratory, clinic, clinical installation, or other medical care facility.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
