

## Article - Business Regulation

§7-302.

- (a) (1) An applicant for a license shall:
  - (i) submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and
  - (ii) pay to the Board:
    - 1. an application fee in the amount set by the Board; and
    - 2. an investigation fee in the amount set by the Board.
- (2) The fees authorized under this subsection may not exceed a total of \$900 for a 2-year term.
- (b) An application shall be made under oath.
- (c) If an applicant wishes to do business as a collection agency at more than 1 place, the applicant shall submit a separate application and pay a separate application fee for each place.
- (d) An application fee is nonrefundable.
- (e) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew the license for additional 2-year terms, if the licensee:
  - (1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
  - (2) pays to the Board a renewal fee in an amount, not exceeding \$900, set by the Board;
  - (3) submits to the Board a renewal application on a form required by the Board; and
  - (4) files with the Board a bond or bond continuation certificate as required under § 7-304 of this subtitle.
