§4-301.

A custodian shall deny inspection of a public record or any part of a public record if:

- (1) by law, the public record is privileged or confidential; or
- (2) the inspection would be contrary to:
 - (i) a State statute;
 - (ii) a federal statute or a regulation that is issued under the statute and has the force of law;
 - (iii) the rules adopted by the Court of Appeals; or
 - (iv) an order of a court of record.
