1 (2) "ADVISORY COMMITTEE" MEANS A COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY 2 <u>STATUTE OR REGULATION</u> THAT FUNCTIONS AS A SUBUNIT OF A HEALTH 3 OCCUPATIONS BOARD.

4 (3) "HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD" MEANS A BOARD AUTHORIZED 5 TO ISSUE A LICENSE, CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

6 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT SERVE CONCURRENTLY AS A MEMBER OF A 7 HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD OR AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND AS AN ELECTED 8 OFFICER OF A PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION <u>ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE</u> 9 <u>STATE</u> THAT REPRESENTS <u>AND ADVOCATES FOR</u> THE INTERESTS OF THE 10 INDIVIDUALS REGULATED BY THE <u>THAT</u> HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2015.
