Vehicle Laws - Single Registration Plate


- FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a single registration plate to all classes of vehicles; providing for the method of attachment of the registration plate; making certain conforming changes, a certain stylistic change, and a certain technical correction; requiring the publisher of the Annotated Code of Maryland to make certain corrections; and generally relating to vehicle registration plates.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article – Transportation

- 17 13-410.
- 18 (a) (1) [Except as otherwise provided in this title, when] **WHEN** it registers a vehicle, the Administration shall issue [to the owner:
- 20 (i) One ONE registration plate, if the vehicle is a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle, Class F (tractor) vehicle, or Class G (trailer) vehicle; and
- 22 (ii) Two registration plates for every other vehicle] TO THE OWNER

23 **OF THE VEHICLE**.





- 1 (6) A county sticker issued under this subsection may not be placed on a special registration plate or a commemorative registration plate issued under Subtitle 6 of this title.
- 4 (d) Registration plates may be reflectorized and shall be manufactured of a 5 material warranted to have a durability of at least 5 years. However, prior to registration 6 plates being reflectorized, the Administration shall obtain approval of the General 7 Assembly through a budget item.
- 8 (e) (1) During subsequent registration years, the Administrator may order the continued use of registration plates that are valid during any current registration year, and, after so doing, the Administrator shall issue, at the time a vehicle's registration is renewed, a validation tab to evidence payment of the vehicle's annual registration fee.
- 12 (2) The tab shall be displayed on the [plates] PLATE of the vehicle in the 13 manner that the Administrator requires.
- 14 (3) The Administrator from time to time shall evaluate the condition of 15 registration plates issued under this title and may provide for the manufacture and 16 issuance of new registration plates. These new registration plates shall be issued and 17 subsequently validated in the manner required by this subtitle.
- 18 (f) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (d) of this section, the 19 Administration may issue reflectorized registration plates under §§ 13–618 and 20 13–619 of this title.
- 21 (g) The dimensions of a registration plate issued for a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle 22 shall be 7 inches wide by 4 inches high.

- 24 (a) [On a vehicle for which two registration plates are required, one plate shall be 25 attached on the front and the other on the rear of the vehicle.
- 26 (b) On a vehicle for which one registration plate is required, the **THE** 27 **REGISTRATION** plate shall be attached on the:
- 28 (1) Front of the vehicle for a Class F (tractor) vehicle; and
- 29 (2) Rear of the vehicle for every other vehicle.
- 30 [(c)] (B) At all times, [each] THE registration plate shall be:
- 31 (1) Maintained free from foreign materials, including A registration plate 32 [covers] COVER as defined in § 13–411.1 of this subtitle, and in a condition to be clearly 33 legible; and

elsewhere on the vehicle.

(2)Securely fastened to the vehicle for which it is issued: 1 2 (i) In a horizontal position; 3 In a manner that prevents the plate from swinging; and (ii) 4 In a place and position to be clearly visible. (iii) 5 [(d)] **(C)** Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle Law, 6 as to any vehicle required to be registered under this title, a person may not drive the 7 vehicle on any highway in this State, unless there is attached to the vehicle and displayed 8 on it, as required in this title: 9 A registration plate [or plates] issued for the vehicle by the 10 Administration for the current registration period; and 11 (2)Any validation tab issued for the vehicle under this subtitle. 12 [(e)] **(D)** Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle Law, 13 as to any vehicle required to be registered under this title, the owner of the vehicle may not permit the vehicle to be driven on any highway in this State, unless there is attached to 14 15 and displayed on the vehicle, as required in this title: 16 A registration plate [or plates] issued by the Administration for the (1) 17 current registration period; and 18 (2) Any validation tab issued for the vehicle under this subtitle. 19 [(f)] **(E)** Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle Law, 20 a vehicle used or driven in this State may not display on either its front or rear any expired 21registration plate issued by any state. 22[(g)] **(F)** Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle Law, 23a person may not display or permit to be displayed on any vehicle used or driven in this 24State any registration plate issued for another vehicle or to a person other than the owner 25of the vehicle. 26 [(h)] (G) (1) A vehicle registered as a historic or antique vehicle (Class L) in 27this State or in another state, when used or driven in this State, may display vintage 28registration plates as an indication of the historic or antique nature of the vehicle. Except 29 as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the place on the vehicle provided for the 30 display of A registration [plates] PLATE may only be used for the display of THE current registration [plates] PLATE in accordance with subsections (a) [through (c)] AND (B) of 31 32 this section, and any vintage registration plates which are used shall be displayed

- 1 (2) If the Administration authorizes the display of vintage registration 2 plates in lieu of **THE** current registration [plates] **PLATE**, as provided in § 13–936.1 of this 3 title, the vintage registration plates shall be displayed as required under subsections (a) 4 [through (c)] **AND** (B) of this section. However, the current registration [plates] **PLATE** shall be kept in the vehicle at all times.
 - [(i)] (H) It is the duty of every police officer to report to the Administration all vehicles operated in violation of this section. The Administration shall verify whether the owner of a reported vehicle has complied with this section.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any reference in the Annotated Code of Maryland to multiple registration plates rendered obsolete by this Act shall be corrected by the publisher of the Annotated Code, in consultation with the Department of Legislative Services, with no further action required by the General Assembly. The publisher shall adequately describe corrections made under this section in the editor's note following the section affected.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2015.
