A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Board of License Commissioners – Notice and Hearing on**
3 **Proposed Legislation**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Calvert County Board of License Commissioners, before
5 submitting a legislative proposal to the Calvert County Delegation for introduction
6 as a bill in a session of the General Assembly, to post notice of the proposal and hold
7 a public hearing on the proposal at least a certain amount of time before the start of
8 the General Assembly session; and generally relating to legislative proposals
9 concerning alcoholic beverages in Calvert County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

23 15–112.

24 (a) (1) The boards of license commissioners in this State may issue the
25 alcoholic beverages licenses provided for by this article in their respective jurisdictions.

1 (2) Each board may employ a secretary and inspectors, clerical and other
2 assistance as is necessary, and fix the compensation of the employees, except as otherwise
3 provided by this article.

4 (3) In this section, "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners,
5 unless otherwise noted.

6 (f) (1) This subsection applies only in Calvert County.

7 (2) The Board may appoint:

8 (i) A clerk and an attorney at a salary to be set by the County
9 Commissioners; and

10 (ii) With the approval of the County Commissioners, full-time or
11 part-time alcoholic beverages inspectors whose salary shall be set by the County
12 Commissioners on an annual or per diem basis, and who shall be paid reasonable expenses
13 related to performance of duties.

14 **(3) AT LEAST 6 MONTHS BEFORE SUBMITTING A LEGISLATIVE**
15 **PROPOSAL TO THE CALVERT COUNTY DELEGATION FOR INTRODUCTION AS A BILL**
16 **IN A SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE BOARD SHALL:**

17 **(I) POST NOTICE OF THE PROPOSAL ON THE BOARD'S WEB**
18 **SITE; AND**

19 **(II) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSAL IN THE**
20 **COUNTY.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
22 1, 2015.
