- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 17 (e) (1) To encourage the location and development of business operations and
- 18 expansion of the employment base in Charles County, the governing body of Charles
- 19 County and of a municipal corporation in Charles County may grant, by law, a property tax
- 20 credit against the county and municipal corporation property tax imposed on any property
- 21 owned **OR LEASED** by a new or expanding business that creates 10 or more full-time jobs
- 22 in an industry targeted for expansion by the Charles County Economic Development
- 23 Commission.
