SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (a) A murder that is not in the first degree under § 2–201 of this subtitle is in the 16 second degree.

17 (b) A person who commits a murder in the second degree is guilty of a felony and 18 on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [30] **40** years.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2015.
