15	WHEREAS, Synthetic plastic microbeads, a synthetic alternative ingredient to such				
16	natural materials as ground almonds, oatmeal, and pumice, found in over 100 personal care				
17	products including facial cleansers, shampoos, and toothpastes, pose a serious threat to the				
18	State's environment; and				
19	WHEREAS, Although synthetic plastic microbeads are a safe and effective mile				
20	abrasive ingredient used for gently removing dead skin, there are concerns about the				
21	potential environmental impact of these materials; and				
22	WHEREAS, Synthetic plastic microbeads have been documented to collect harmful				
23	pollutants already present in the environment and harm fish and other aquatic organisms				

that form the base of the aquatic food chain; and



- 1 WHEREAS, While more research is needed on the potential adverse consequences 2 synthetic plastic microbeads may have on the environment, many cosmetic manufacturers 3 have already begun a voluntary process for identifying alternatives to synthetic plastic 4 microbeads; and
- WHEREAS, Without significant and costly improvements to the majority of the 5 State's sewage treatment facilities, synthetic plastic microbeads will continue to pollute 6
- 7 Maryland's waters; now, therefore,
