1 AN ACT concerning

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Department of Transportation – Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Services – Utilization Study

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the $\mathbf{5}$ Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, to study certain matters relating 6 to the utilization of transportation services provided by the Authority with a certain 7 frequency; requiring the Department to collect, analyze, and evaluate certain 8 information; requiring that the information used in the study be gathered from data 9 obtained within a certain period of time, subject to a certain exception; requiring that 10 information used in the study pertaining to Maryland jurisdictions be organized in 11 a certain manner; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to the 12Governor and certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date 13 with a certain frequency; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally 14relating to a study of the utilization of transportation services provided by the 15Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority.

3 (4) Information used in the study pertaining to Maryland jurisdictions 4 shall be organized by individual jurisdiction rather than by region, including separating 5 information for Baltimore County and Baltimore City.

6 (b) On or before December 1, 2015, the Department shall submit a report 7 detailing the results of the study conducted under this Act to the Governor and, in 8 accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the Senate Budget and Taxation 9 Committee, the Senate Finance Committee, the House Appropriations Committee, and the

10 House Environment and Transportation Committee.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June

12 1, 2015. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2016, with

- 13 no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no
- 14 further force and effect.
