A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Law Enforcement Officers – Video Cameras**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain law enforcement officer to wear a video camera
4 affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on duty; requiring that a
5 recording be preserved by a law enforcement agency for a certain period of time;
6 requiring a law enforcement agency to develop certain policies and procedures;
7 providing that this Act does not apply to a law enforcement officer who is on detective
8 duty; providing that it is lawful under a certain provision of law for a certain law
9 enforcement officer to intercept a certain oral communication; defining a certain
10 term; and generally relating to law enforcement officers and video cameras.
