- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the size of the safety zone for archery hunters in Harford
- 4 County within which archery hunting may not take place except under certain
- 5 circumstances; and generally relating to archery hunting in Harford County.

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Natural Resources

- 15 (g) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a
- 16 person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may
- 17 not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the
- 18 "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by
- safety zone, of a twenting nouse, residence, charten, of other banding of early occupied by
- 19 human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, without
- 20 the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- 21 (2) A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not shoot or
- 22 discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during school hours
- 23 or at a time when a school-approved activity is taking place.

- 1 (3) (i) For archery hunters in Carroll County or Frederick County, the 2 safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a 3 dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 4 (ii) For archery hunters in [Harford County or] Montgomery County, 5 the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a 6 dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 7 (III) FOR ARCHERY HUNTERS IN HARFORD COUNTY, THE 8 SAFETY ZONE DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION EXTENDS FOR 75 9 YARDS FROM A DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR ANY OTHER BUILDING 10 OR CAMP OCCUPIED BY HUMAN BEINGS.
- During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
