1 AN ACT concerning

2 Maryland Health Care Commission – University of Maryland School of Medicine 3 – Workgroup to Study Issues Related to Uterine Fibroids – Study

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Health Care Commission, in consultation with 4 $\mathbf{5}$ University of Maryland School of Medicine to convene a workgroup that includes 6 representatives from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, certain 7experts, and interested stakeholders, to conduct a study of issues related to the 8 incidence of uterine fibroids in the State; requiring the study workgroup to examine 9 certain issues; requiring, on or before a certain date, the Commission University of 10 Maryland School of Medicine to report certain findings to certain committees of the 11 General Assembly; and generally relating to the Maryland Health Care Commission 12and a study of workgroup convened by the University of Maryland School of Medicine to study issues related to uterine fibroids. 13

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

16 (a) The Maryland Health Care Commission, in consultation with University of 17 Maryland School of Medicine shall convene a workgroup that includes representatives of 18 the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, experts in uterine fibroids, and interested 19 stakeholders, shall conduct a to study of issues related to the incidence of uterine fibroids 20 in the State.

1 The study conducted workgroup convened under subsection (a) of this section (b) $\mathbf{2}$ shall examine: 3 (1)the incidence of uterine fibroids among women in the State, by race, ethnicity, age, and county of residence; 4 the types of treatments and procedures used to treat uterine fibroids; $\mathbf{5}$ (2)6 data on the number of women in the State who undergo a hysterectomy, (3)7 myomectomy, or other type of treatment for uterine fibroids each year; 8 (4) alternative, innovative, and less invasive treatments and procedures 9 that are available to treat uterine fibroids; 10whether there is a need for more research to study the cause and (5)11 treatment of uterine fibroids; and 12(6)whether licensed physicians in the State are willing and able to perform 13less invasive procedures to treat uterine fibroids. On or before June 30, 2016, the Maryland Health Care Commission University 14(c) 15of Maryland School of Medicine shall report, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the findings of the study conducted workgroup convened under 16 17subsection (a) of this section to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs 18 Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee. 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 201, 2015.
