14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
16	Article - Transportation
17	4–202.
18	(a) The Secretary of Transportation is the Chairman of the Authority.
19	(b) (1) In addition to the Chairman, the Authority consists of [eight]:
20	(I) EIGHT members appointed by the Governor with the advice and
21	consent of the Senate; AND



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THE MAJORITY PARTY; OR

1	(II) SERVING IN A NONVOTING ADVISORY CAPACITY ONLY:
2 3	1. Two members of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; and
4 5	2. Two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House.
6 7	(2) The [appointed] members of the Authority APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR may not be employees of the Executive Branch of the State government.
8	(3) Of the [appointed] members APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:
9	(i) One shall have expertise in structural engineering;
10	(ii) One shall have expertise in transportation planning;
11	(iii) One shall have expertise in land use planning; and
12	(iv) One shall have expertise in finance.
13 14 15	(4) The [appointed] members of the Authority APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR shall reflect the racial, gender, and geographic diversity of the population of the State.
16 17 18	(5) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE:
19 20	1. IN EACH INSTANCE, SHALL INCLUDE ONE MEMBER OF THE MAJORITY PARTY AND ONE MEMBER OF THE MINORITY PARTY; AND
21 22 23	2. SHALL REPRESENT A LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT THAT INCLUDES A TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES PROJECT, TO THE EXTENT THAT THERE IS A SENATOR OR DELEGATE THAT FULFILLS THAT CRITERIA.
24 25 26	(II) IF THERE IS NOT A SENATOR OR DELEGATE FROM THE APPROPRIATE PARTY WHO REPRESENTS A LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT THAT SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I)2 OF THIS PARAGRAPH:
27 28 29	1. THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, AS APPROPRIATE, MAY APPOINT ANY MEMBER FROM THE MAJORITY PARTY TO FILL THAT OPEN SLOT IF THE POSITION IS SLOTTED FOR A MEMBER OF

5 6 7	(c) (1) Each [appointed] member APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR OR BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE serves for a term of 4 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
8 9 10	(2) The terms of the [appointed] members APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Authority on January 1, 2007.
11 12	(3) [An appointed] A member APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR may not serve more than three consecutive terms.
13 14 15	(4) (I) A member appointed BY THE GOVERNOR OR BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term.
16 17 18 19 20	(II) IF A LEGISLATIVE MEMBER RETIRES OR OTHERWISE CEASES TO BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DURING THE MEMBER'S TERM ON THE AUTHORITY, THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY FOR THAT MEMBER MAY APPOINT A NEW MEMBER TO FILL THE VACANCY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM.
21 22	(d) (1) A member of the Authority APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR is entitled to:
23	[(1)] (I) The compensation provided in the State budget; and
24 25	[(2)] (II) Reimbursement for expenses, in accordance with the Standard State Travel Regulations of the Department of Budget and Management.
26	(2) A LEGISLATIVE MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY:
27 28	(I) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY; BUT
29 30	(II) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET

31 AND MANAGEMENT.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
