# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### **Commercial Law – Consumer Protection – Ticket Transfers**

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a ticket seller or an operator of a ticket seller's Web site from prohibiting the transfer of a certain ticket, requiring an additional fee for the 4  $\mathbf{5}$ transfer of a certain ticket, or requiring a purchaser of a ticket to present certain 6 identification or a certain credit card to gain entry to an entertainment event; and generally relating to the purchase and transfer of tickets. 7
